# **NISSAN: PRODUCTION CONTINUES TO ROLL**

Nissan Canton will soon celebrate its 18th anniversary as one of Mississippi's premier manufacturing plants. Employing over 5,250 people, this 4.7 million square foot plant produces the Nissan Altima, Frontier, and Titan models among others. Plant capacity is now about 450,000 vehicles annually. This automotive plant is just one example of this industry's migration to the South.

Metro will soon complete a HVAC renovation of the Tire and Wheel Assembly plant. This Design/Build project involves removal of the existing heating-only units and replacing them with new Cooling/Heating systems.

Like many manufacturing environments, Nissan personnel work around the clock. Metro's work required special scheduling through weekends and holidays to accommodate minimal disruption to the production process. Metro was the prime contractor for this renovation.

# SAFETY CORNER: CONSTRUCTION IS A DANGER 70NF

OSHA statistics are dis-heartening to read. Construction accounts for 1 in 5 lives lost in the workplace. The Fatal Four are major construction risks – falls, electrical, struck-by, and caught in. How do you buffer these risks in such a climate?

There is no single answer to such a question. It is a combination of awareness, use of PPE, regular reminders, inspections, and training. At Metro, we take safety as serious as any one thing we do. With just under 275,000 hours worked in our last 12 months, we are proud of our safety record. The standard term in the worker's comp industry is EMR (experience modifier rate). Our EMR today is .78 (22% better than average). In an inherently dangerous trade, Metro has proven accident prevention is a controllable factor.

Thanks to our leadership in this area who are the front line in keeping our personnel safe and returning home each day to their families. Congratulations on another banner safety year!
