

## NATCHEZ-ADAMS SCHOOL DISTRICT PREPARES FOR NEW HIGH SCHOOL

The Natchez-Adams School District has committed more than $\$ 34$ million for a new high school complex and major renovations to the existing high school including a conversion to the middle school. Under the leadership of Superintendent Fred Butcher, this new facility will add over 100,000 square feet of space for this district. Natchez-Adams serves more than 3,000 students with more than 600 in grades 10-12. They were one of the first schools in Mississippi to offer early college credits through their high school program and are pleased to boast a $100 \%$ graduation rate on those participating in this curriculum.

Don M. Barron Contractor of Farmerville, Louisiana is the general contractor for this new school. This is Metro Mechanical's first project with Barron with a planned completion date of August 2022. Our work includes site utilities, water, storm, sanitary and grease waste along with roof top units, packaged heat pumps, fans, ductwork, and controls. The school will house a central cafeteria, gymnasium, stage area for special events, and four classroom wings.
